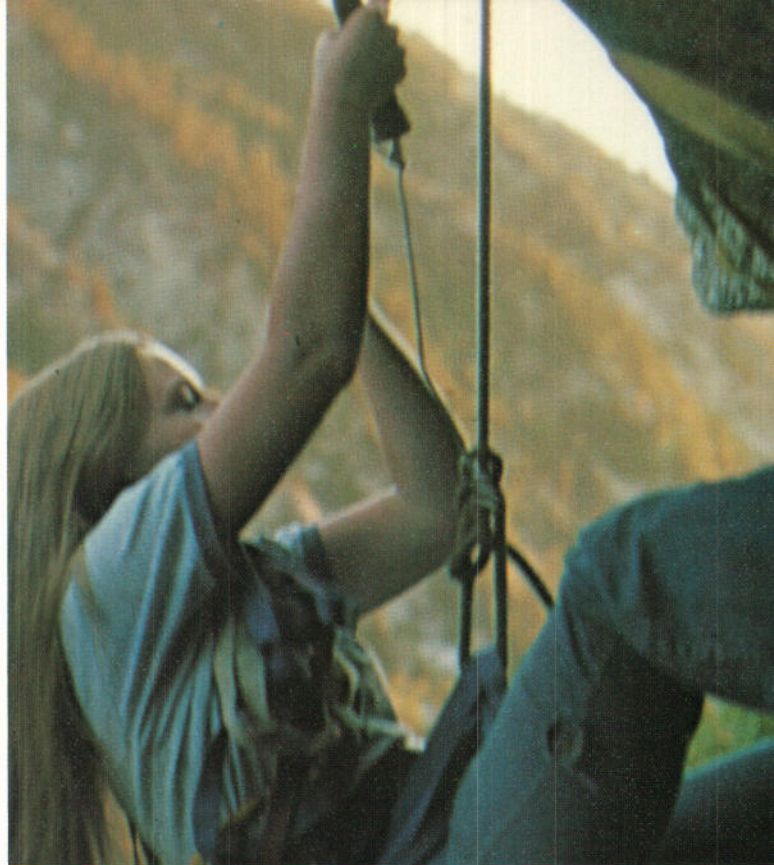
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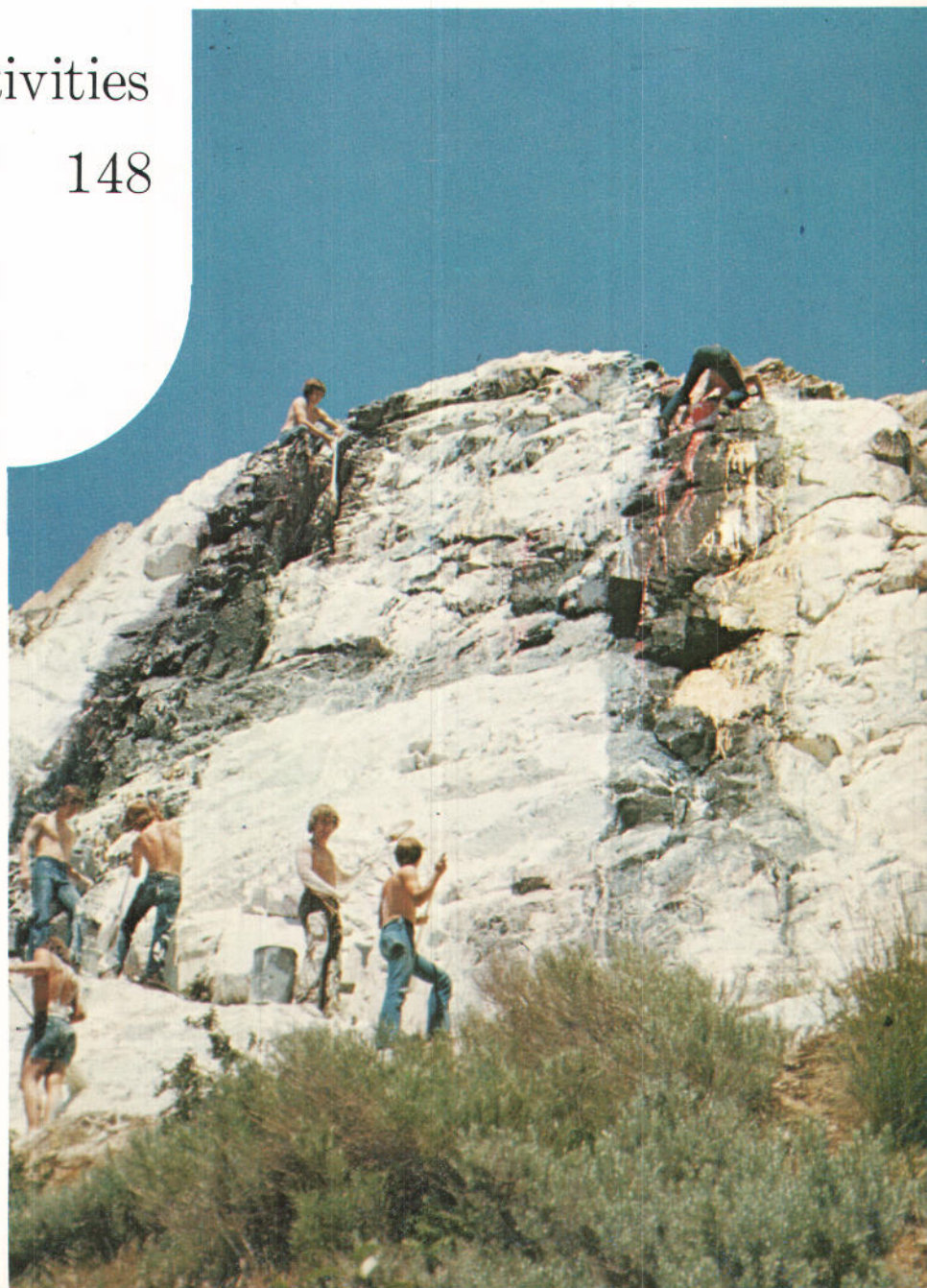
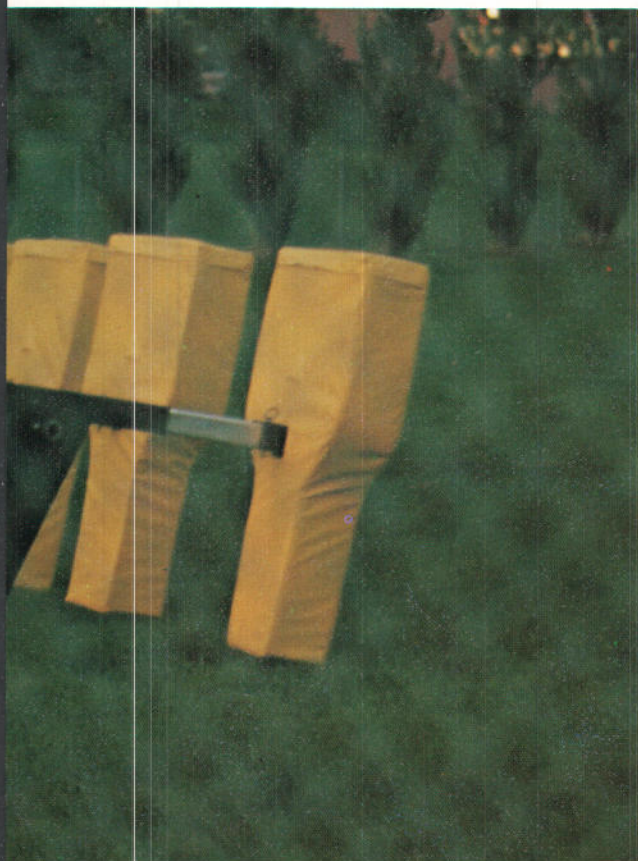


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With peace of mind and an innocent smile

too painful to set aside the masquerade.



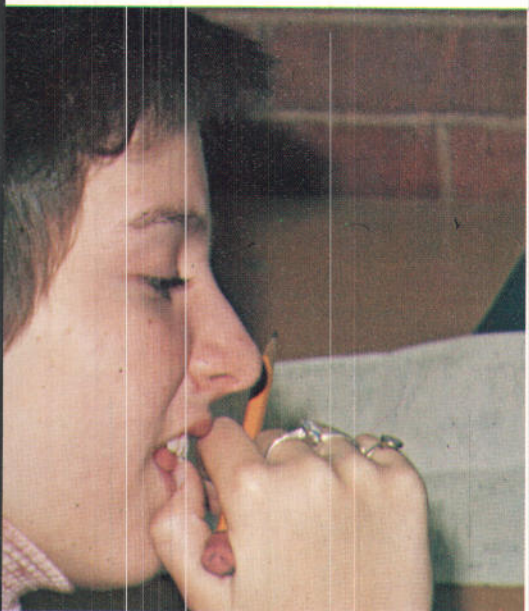
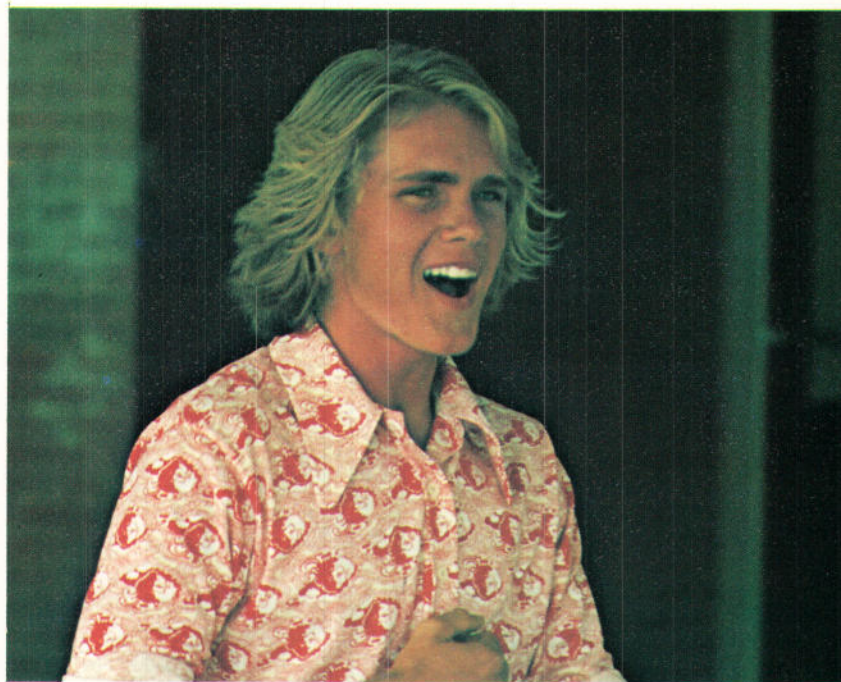

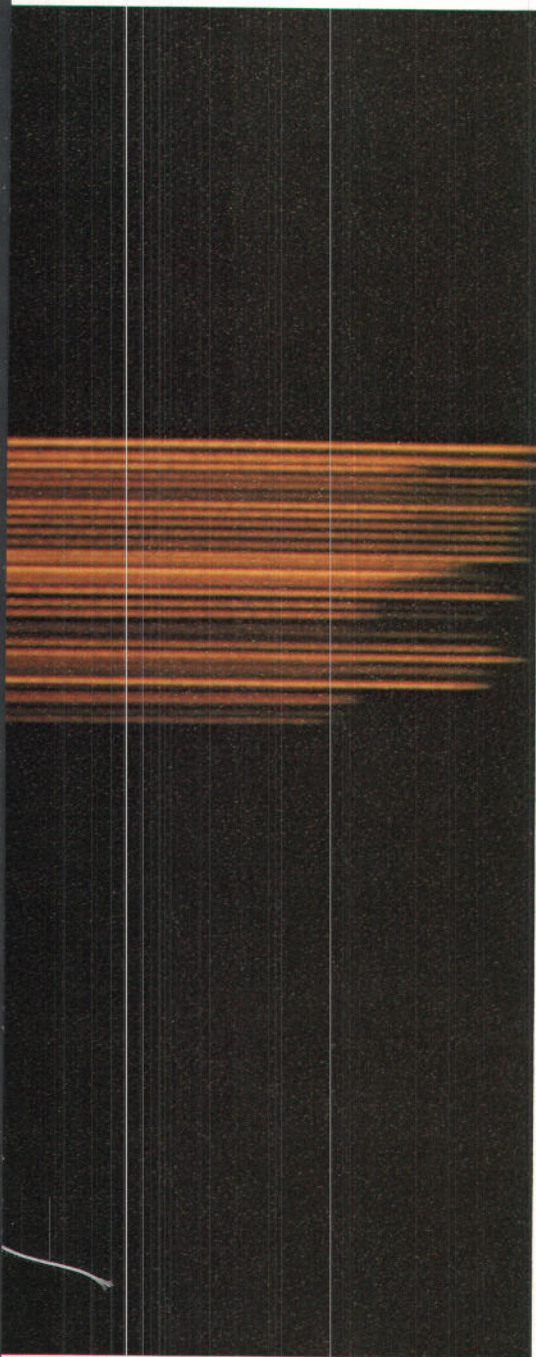
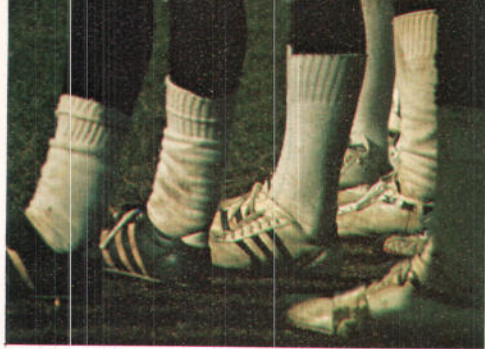




# Finding ourselves phased out

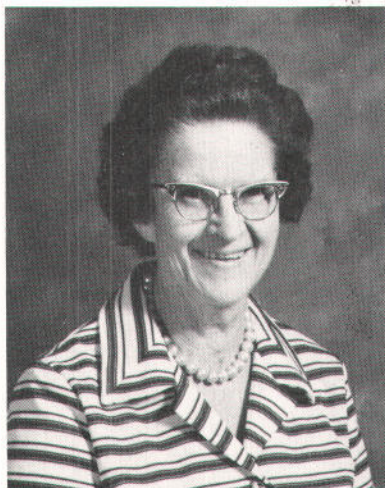


# Retiring Teachers

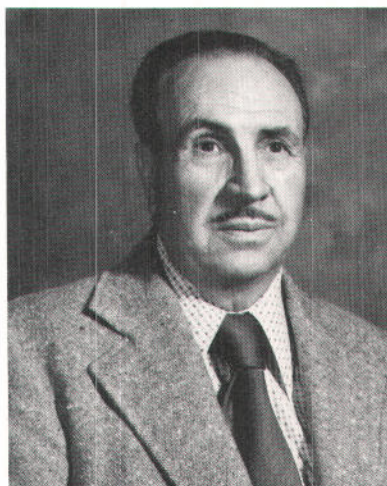
**Ms. Eleanor Brady**

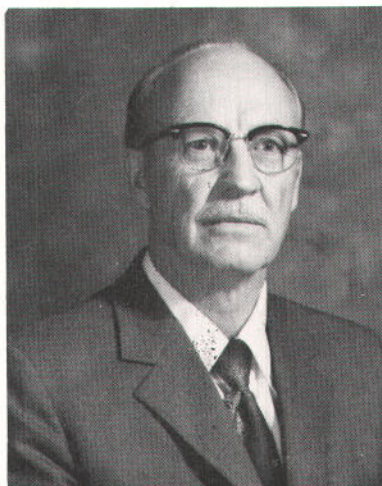
**Ms. Alice Slusser**

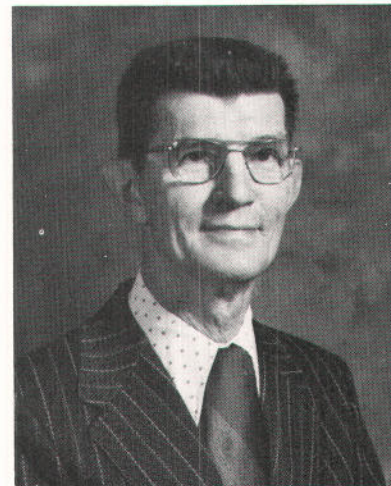
**Mr. Weldon Grandy**

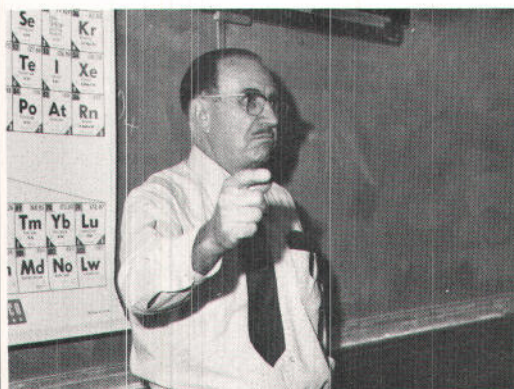
**Mr. Arthur Hughes**

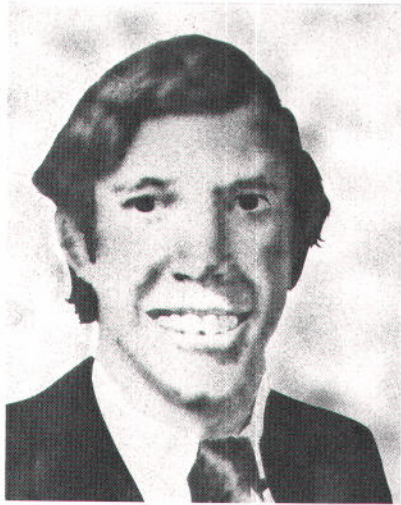
**Mr. Gordon Newby**

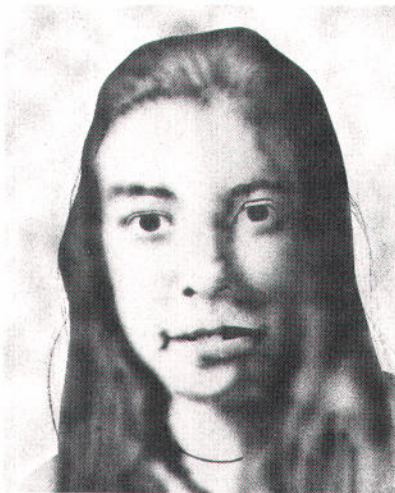

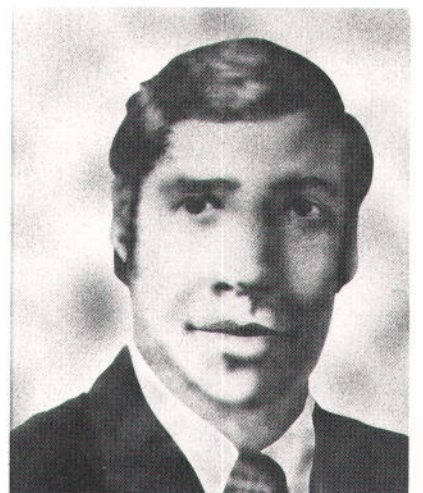

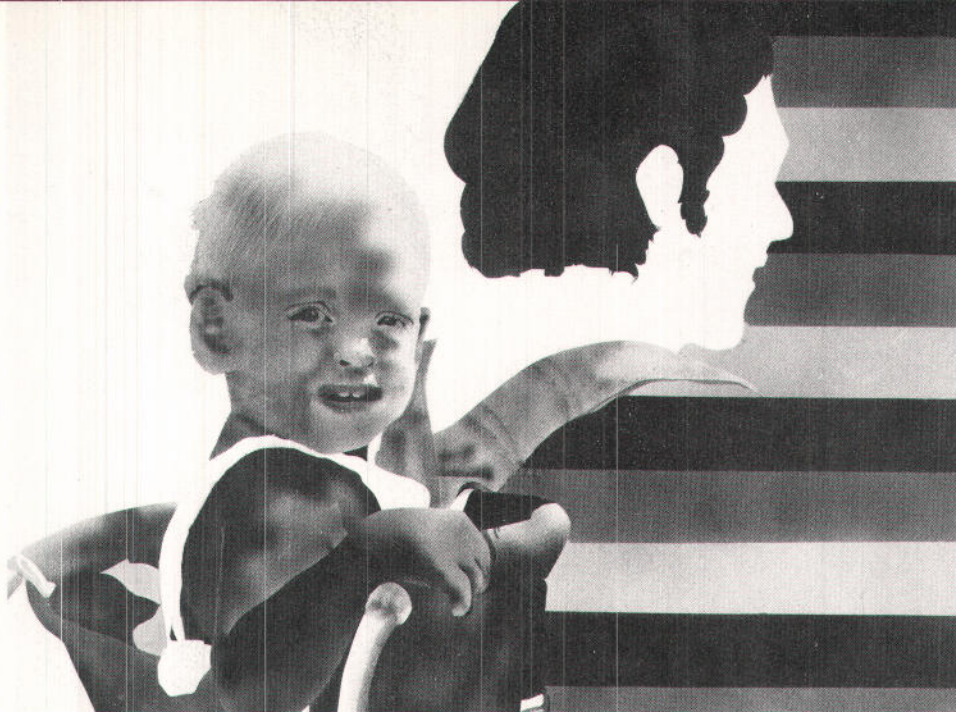
